*** Select which of (a) or (b) would be the correct refereeing decision in each case:

- Q1. Red is tackled by Blue. On rising to play the ball, Red stands on the touch line.**
- A1. a) Touch Judge raises the flag to indicate in touch?
b) No action by the Touch Judge, prior call of “play-the-ball” by referee?
- Q2. Blue is awarded a penalty and elects to kick for touch. The ball crosses the touch line at the halfway and lands on the touch line at the Red 30 metre mark. What is the Touch Judge signal?**
- A2. a) Ball into touch at the 30 metre mark?
b) Ball into touch at the halfway?
- Q3. On fifth and last tackle, Red grubber kicks the ball which rebounds off a Blue player and rolls into touch.**
- A3. a) Scrum 20 metres in from where the ball entered touch. LHF to Blue?
b) Handover to Blue 10 metres in from where the ball entered touch?
- Q4. Red passes the ball backwards to another inside Red player who juggles the ball. Before the ball hits the ground, this Red player kicks the ball.**
- A4. a) Play on?
b) Scrum, LHF to Blue?
- Q5. On Tackle 4, Red kicks. The ball is charged down by Blue and regathered by Red who is tackled.**
- A5. a) Play-the-ball, Red, Tackle 1?
b) Play-the-ball, Red, Zero Tackle?
- Q6. Red knocks on in the field-of-play. The ball rolls into the Blue in-goal. Blue regathers the ball and is tackled over the dead ball line.**
- A6. a) Goal line drop out by Blue?
b) Scrum for knock by Red. LHF to Blue?

Q7. Red plays the ball and has no acting halfback or marker. The Red player who played the ball regains the ball.

- A7. a) Penalty to Blue?
b) Play on by Red?

Q8. A defending Blue player, in possession, is tackled bestriding his own goal line in an upright position.

- A8. a) Scrum 10 metres out from the Blue goal line in line with where Blue is held up. LHF to Red?
b) Goal line drop out?

Q9. Red kicks the ball, on Tackle 3, which accidentally rebounds off another Red player in front of the kicker. The Red kicker regathers the ball.

- A9. a) Penalty against Red?
b) Scrum for the accidental interference LHF to Blue.

Q10. Red stands to play the ball on the last play-the-ball. Red drops the ball before playing it.

- A10. a) Scrum. LHF to Blue?
b) Handover to Blue?
