INTRODUCTION

When I first started in Group 8 at Canberra there were no junior games as we have in Penrith, but there were juniors which played at Goulburn and with me having no transport (only a pushbike) I was not able to get there. However, I was able to run most of the school games in Canberra.

At the outset, I just wanted to do something with football, not being able to play due to a rib injury, then later as I settled in it was time to set goals - which was to be an "A" Grade Referee, easier said than achieved.

The Appointments Board in Group 8 at the time consisted of clubmen who rang in reports to a Coordinator who was a non active referee. Your report was graded on how their team went - good if a win and not so good if a loss (but that's vastly different than metropolitan associations have at the moment).

Over the years I have seen many changes which in turn have improved the game up to today's level. To mention a few which I believe affects a referee greatly,

1. Six tackle means constant running of a game without constant stoppages and/or scrums;
2. 5 metres (now 10 metres) requires a referee to be able to move around quickly and be in position.

This last change brings in further requirements, that is - control, adjudication, communicating with players, respect of players, commitment - all brought down to one word - **consistency**.

To be consistent, a referee has firstly to be FIT - which means training, being association or self, so as to get into position to be able to adjudicate correctly. When this occurs you will gain respect of players and less hassles with the game, eventually culminating in confidence in yourself. To mention a model of consistency one would have had to see the U19 Division 1 Grand Final at the Penrith Stadium by our Secretary, Gary Haines. All throughout the game every decision was correct and warranted, no dissent by either side because he was fit enough to be in position. (Just to add a comment I did notice two mistakes of a minor nature but they were missed by players so it went unnoticed!)

3. Finally, one should not referee just for the monetary value but be committed to the advancement of refereeing and fostering of rugby league. Also whilst doing this, enjoy your efforts.

One lasting episode that will stay with me was when mini and mod league was introduced. After a try was scored the referee indicated to the table the value of the try and turned the player around to allow the officials to record his jersey number. On this particular ground, the officials at the table complained to the referee at half time that due to the number of players milling around they missed the number. "I'll fix that" he said. So on the next try the referee took hold of try scorer and lifted the player completely into the air with his number towards the table, "Will this do?", he asked and then put the player down. Well done, Joe Beacroft.

In closing, I hope that some or all of the topics mentioned can be of help to others, present or future. It is easy to talk of one's experiences but a different matter when putting pen to paper.

One final and important thing. At junior league grounds leave matters to officials which do not affect your job of refereeing; they are better qualified as we have a very fine junior league.

Recruitment

One of the goals for 1993 was to increase the number of members qualified to referee international football to ease the workload of referees on Saturdays.

TREASURER

I am pleased to present to the members my Treasurer's Report and Financial Statements for 1993.

This season saw an unprecedented step taken by the Executive concerning the management of the financial affairs of the Association. As members would be aware, it was necessary for interim arrangements to be put in place following the problems experienced in 1992. To this end, the general committee endorsed the position of Treasurer being performed by the Secretary with assistance from other Executive members, primarily the Assistant Secretary.

Therefore, it is very satisfying to be able to present a very positive financial report for the Association.

In very difficult economic times, the Association has performed extremely well in the financial area. The financial statements reveal a very healthy situation but one which we must continue to treat with caution. To be able to post a balance in excess of \$30,000 is certainly indicative of strong prospects for the future.

It is regularly reported and commented upon, of the poor response by the junior league clubs concerning the payment of referees' fees. In 1993, the clubs responded admirably and regular payments ensured the Association benefited from not only an increased bank balance, but also from additional interest payments. Bill Hubbard is also to be congratulated for his efforts in making the clubs "toe the line".

The recovery of fees is not a small task - as can be seen from the accompanying statements. It was essential therefore to put into place the appropriate procedures to ensure prompt payment and accountability. I believe the Association has now developed some of the best mechanisms to prevent any further shortfalls in its financial accountability.

The payment of members' fees is just as onerous. Sometimes I wonder whether some members appreciate the time involved in allocating fees, checking and double checking calculations and preparing statements when you only hear or see them when it is time to be paid!

The Association's sponsors, Carmen Removals & Storage and Carmen Furniture, again came to the party with financial assistance this year. As Treasurer, I appreciate the support given to the Association by these fine companies and hopefully we will continue the sponsorship arrangements for several more years!

The Association also fared well with grants from the District Club and the TNT group for the development of referees. Thank you to these organisations for their ongoing support to refereeing.

Socially, the members continue to be well looked after with post meeting convivals, training barbeques and other social events. Whilst expenditure in this area is slightly less than in previous years, we must continue to be prudent and responsible when approving expenditure on social activities. Peter Butler as Social Secretary is to be congratulated for his efforts with regard to not only organising our social calendar, but for "receipting" everything from a bag of ice to payment for Ladies Night!

As I will not seek to be elected or seconded to the position of Treasurer in 1994, I would suggest the members consider the investment of funds relating to the item of debt recovery. The Association has already recovered a substantial proportion of this money from the State Bank, and it may be subject to a claim from the bank when all other monies are recovered in approximately three years.

Season 1993 cannot pass without recognition of the support given to me in my capacity as Treasurer.

Firstly, to Peter Browne for his efforts as Assistant Treasurer, thank you. Peter was outstanding in calculating the fees each week and providing assistance when required, particularly with preparing the members' statements. John Kearnes did an excellent job as Gear Steward and provided all the necessary documentation to make deductions from members' fees and the payment of all invoices a very easy task.

To my Executive colleagues, I offer my gratitude for having the faith in me to do the job - your support was appreciated. To the members, most importantly, thank you for allowing me to do the job in an manner which was acceptable to you. We now have available some of the best reporting systems of any association and which are already being cloned by others.

To our internal auditors, Peter Filmer and Steve McFarlane, and to Jenny Mosher - thanks for the advice.

Finally, to my wife Irene and children Kylie, Phillip and Catherine, who gave me the best support, encouragement and advice anyone could possibly receive, a special thank you for being so tolerant and considerate.

SATURDAY FOOTBALL

The weather was kind to the 1993 season for Saturday football with only one round being lost due to inclement weather.

With the ever increasing number of teams competing in the junior league competition, a very heavy workload was placed on members during the trial season with many failing to submit availability sheets on time. As the competition proper began, more members became available to referee and an influx of new recruits eased the situation.

The number of International referees consistently available improved this year and made coverage of games easier but I was not always able to appoint a Development Panel member to all grounds. Any senior member who can assist in this regard will be welcome; if only for a few hours each week to help the less experienced members develop their skills and confidence.

By grand finals time, we had a surplus of referees and competition was keen. All members selected performed creditably and received favourable comments from the clubs involved and the Junior League. In the mini/mod competitions, all Division 1 games were controlled by junior referees, some in their first season of active refereeing.

Malcolm Brown and Troy Priest travelled to the Gold Coast to represent the Association in the annual exchange with Group 18. As expected, both performed with distinction and proved to be worthy ambassadors for the Association.

Early in the season, Alex Davies and Andrew Pesle, attended a one week course at the NSW Rugby League Academy at Narrabeen. Both were commended on their ability and dedication by Denis Braybrook.

In another innovation this year, eight mini/mod referees were invited to travel to Tamworth to officiate at the Peel Schools' Carnival and all received favourable comments for their on field performances. Special thanks are due to Graeme Priest who gave up his weekend to accompany the members on their trip and to the Canberra Association for their support. During the final series at the Sydney Football Stadium, Alex Davies, Martin Duncan and Andrew Pesle were appointed to officiate in an exhibition match in another first for the Association. At the time of writing this report, 19 candidates had obtained their International ticket, with another five to be examined prior to the end of the season.

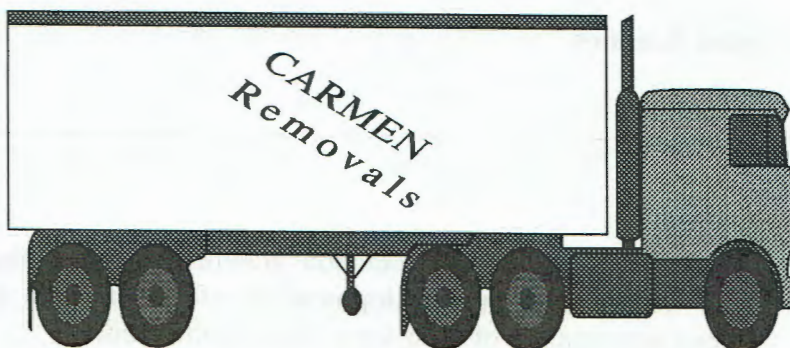
During 1993, six candidates has obtained their mini/mod tickets.
